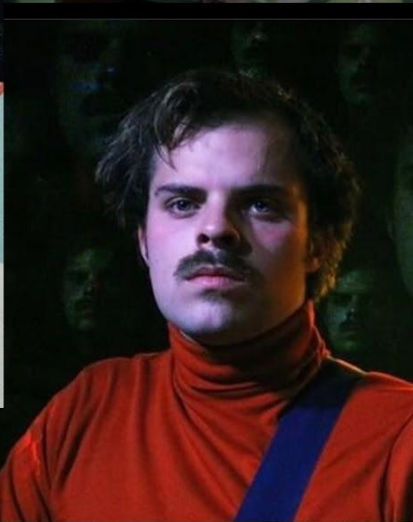
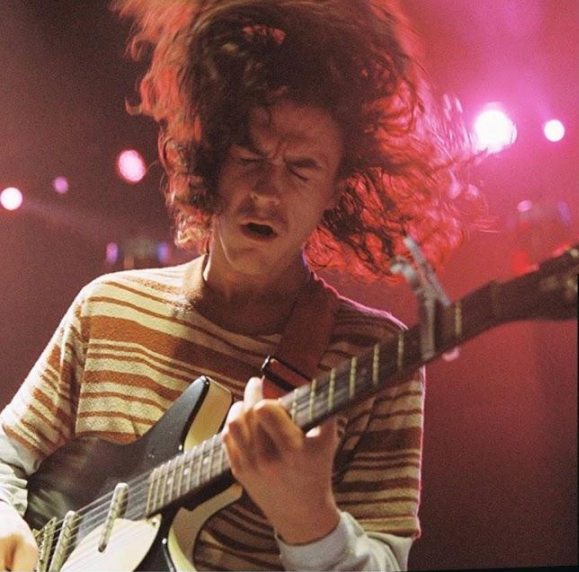

What was the first live show that you played with Peach Pit and what was that experience like?

And it was this packed house, the house party was packed. And we had been practicing for a year. Kinda before that we hadn't played any shows, we practiced really hard for a year. So we played peach pit, we played seventeen, we played alrighty aphrodite, drop the guillotine, and maybe one more, we didn't have any other songs besides those. And it was awesome. And then I remember we went out to the alley of the house afterwards and I was like hugging the guys. We were so excited. The show went we, we were like "we're gonna make it, we're gonna be famous!" And uh I cried hahaha. So yeah anyway I definitely miss those times for sure cause we get to now play all kinds of cool shows all over the place. 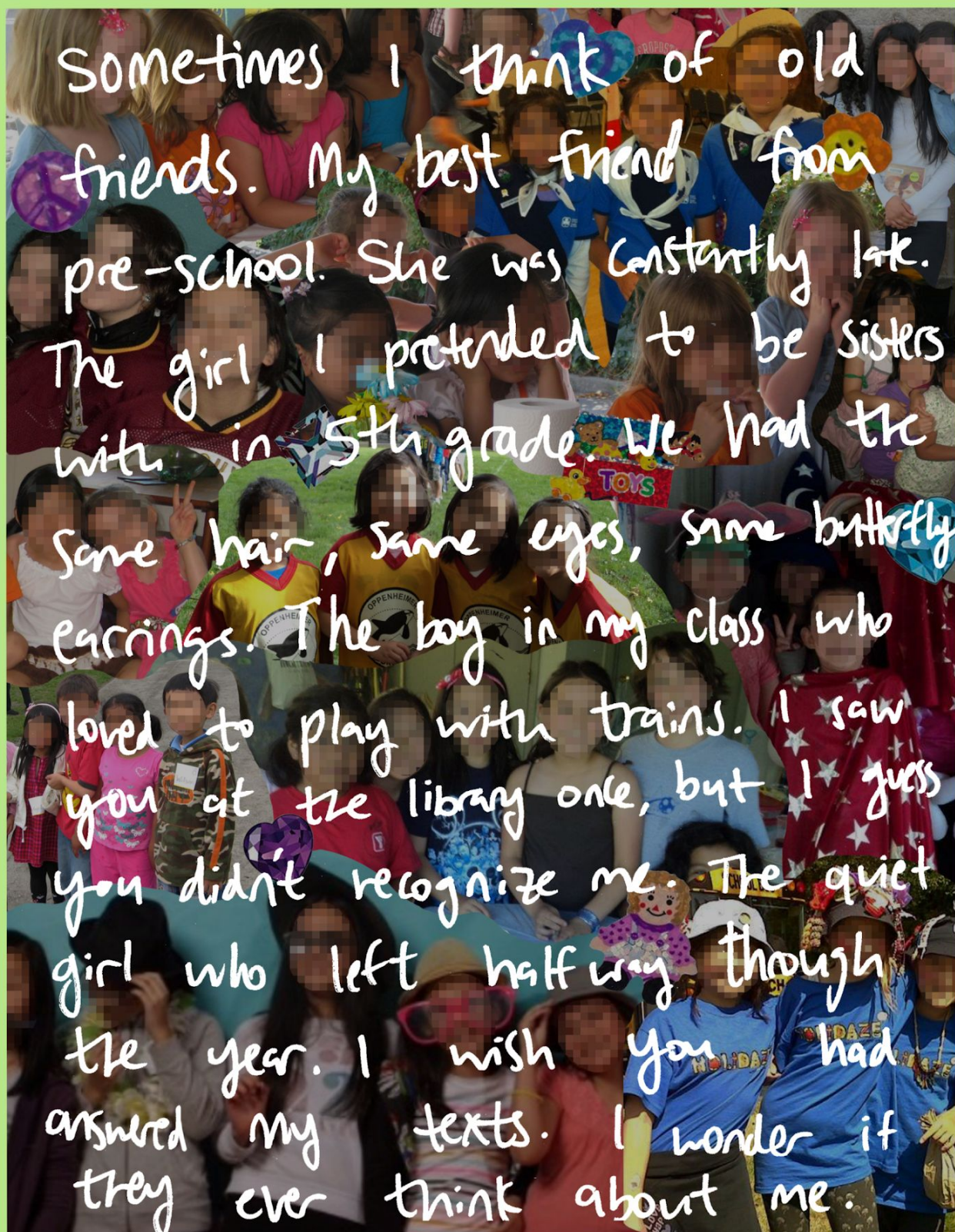
